

### INFLATION

- Inflation is a gradual rising of prices
- Your money buys less
  Economists calculate inflation by using a price level
  - CPI, PPI, GDP deflator





You need to know this!


*Inflation = change in price level x 100* beginning price level

### **CPI: Consumer Price Index**

- The Bureau of Labor Statistics establishes the CPI using a sample of 400 commonly purchased consumer goods
- These goods are known as the market basket

### **Degrees of Inflation**

- There are different types of inflation
  - Creeping inflation • 1-3% a year • Galloping Inflation • 100-300% a year • Hyper Inflation • 500% or more



### **Causes of Inflation**

- 1. Demand pull theory
- 2. Federal Government spends more than it earns
- 3. Rising costs of inputs cause goods to cost more
- 4. Too much money

**Union Activities:** 

Strikes, pickets, boycotts

## Kinds of Union Arrangements

### Closed Shops


Employers only hire union members
 Union Shops

Workers must join the union soon after being hired

## Kinds of Union Arrangements

- Modified Union Shops
  - Workers can voluntarily join the union but must be members as long as they hold the job
- Agency Shops
  - Worker doesn't have to join the union to get or keep a job
  - Must pay union dues to help pay for collective bargaining

# Right-to-Work



Some states have passed right-towork laws to prohibit mandatory union membership

# **Collective Bargaining**

Collective Bargaining: representatives from both management and labor meet to reach agreement

If management and labor cannot reach an agreement in negotiations:

\*Mediation \*Fact-Finding \*Arbitration \*Injunction and Seizure \*Presidential Intervention
